Mayor's Corner

In today's note, I want to provide an update on a few things affecting our community:



COVID-19 Restrictions Update

As a result of continued improvement in key COVID-19 metrics, effective last Friday (February 26), Governor Cooper eased some of the state-wide COVID-19 related restrictions. It's important to note that key indicators for our county also continue to improve. Our on-going commitment to the 3Ws is making a difference!

Following are a few of the changes to the Executive Order:

- The Modified Stay at Home Order for individuals is lifted
- The number of people who may gather indoors will increase from 10 to 25, while 50 remains the limit for outdoor gatherings
- The curfew on the sale of alcohol for onsite consumption will be moved from 9 pm to 11 pm
- Many businesses, venues, and arenas will have increased occupancy both indoors and outdoors
