# **Town Council Meeting Minutes**

June 14, 2022 – 6:00 PM

The Town Council of Bermuda Run held its scheduled meeting on Tuesday, May 10, 2022 at 6:00 PM. The meeting was held at the Bermuda Run Town Hall.

#### Adoption of the Agenda

Council Member Curtis Capps made a motion to approve the agenda. Council Member Mike Brannon seconded the motion. The motion was approved by a vote of four (4) in favor and none opposed.

#### Approval of the May 10, 2022 Town Council Meeting Minutes

Council Member Heather Coleman made a motion to approve the May 10, 2022 meeting minutes. Council Member Melinda Szeliga seconded the motion. The motion was approved by a vote of four (4) in favor and none opposed.

#### Citizens' Comments - NONE

#### Public Hearing - Recommended 2022-2023 Budget

The Town Manager's original recommended budget for the General Fund is balanced at \$1,934,000.00, Gate Operations Fund balanced at \$530,850.00, and Utilities Fund balanced at \$530,850.00. The proposed budget has been duly advertised on the Town's website and a hard copy has been made available at Town Hall for review.

The Town Manager requested consideration of an amended General Fund budget balanced at \$2,193,860.00. Consideration of the amended budget includes a projected increase in ABC revenues based on updated trends and an allocation of \$200,000.00 in Powell Bill Fund Balance to provide additional resources for streets and street right-of-way maintenance. The Town Council may take action tonight to adopt the proposed budget ordinance as presented, may approve as amended, or take no action. A budget, however, must be adopted prior to July 1, 2022.

Mayor Cross Opened the Public Hearing *There were no public comments*.

Mayor Cross Closed the Public Hearing

Council Member Mike Brannon made a motion to adopt the proposed budget ordinance as presented. Council Member Heather Coleman seconded the motion. The motion was approved by a vote of four (4) in favor and none opposed.

#### Town Manager/Council/Mayor Comments

Lee Rollins – Gave update regarding RISE emergency easement, decommissioning of the waste water treatment facility/Juniper pump station, and reminded attendees of concert on Saturday.

Heather Coleman – Excited for the new fiscal year. Sad to see Lee Rollins leave, stating that he is the reason that she is here on the Council.

Mike Brannon – Thanked everyone that attended the recent Public Input Session regarding the Comprehensive Plan, and everyone that voted in recent election stating that the turnout was impressive for both. Impressed with the smooth process of the early-voting at Town Hall.

Melinda Szeliga – Introduced Davie High STEM student, Sean Lane who is shadowing her as a Town Council Member/Real Estate professional. Recognized Lee Rollins' dedication and also agreed that he makes the Town Council roles easier.

Curtis Capps – Thanked all in attendance and stated that he never realized how much a Town Manager does until he worked closely with Lee Rollins.
