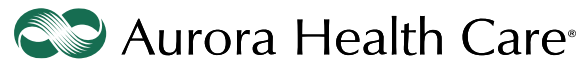

# Volume Growth

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## Surgical/ GI Services

Continued growth in surgical volumes 11% over 2023

Same Day Discharge initiative for Total Joints

- 16% → 40% in 2024

Endoscopy

- 8% increase in 2024

## Emergency Department

Volume 29,468 visits with minimal impact on throughput

- Door to provider 12 mins
- Transfers 5.6%
- Admitted 3,032 patients (10%)

## Inpatient Services

Expanded to 4 additional beds with all 50 inpatient beds open/staffed

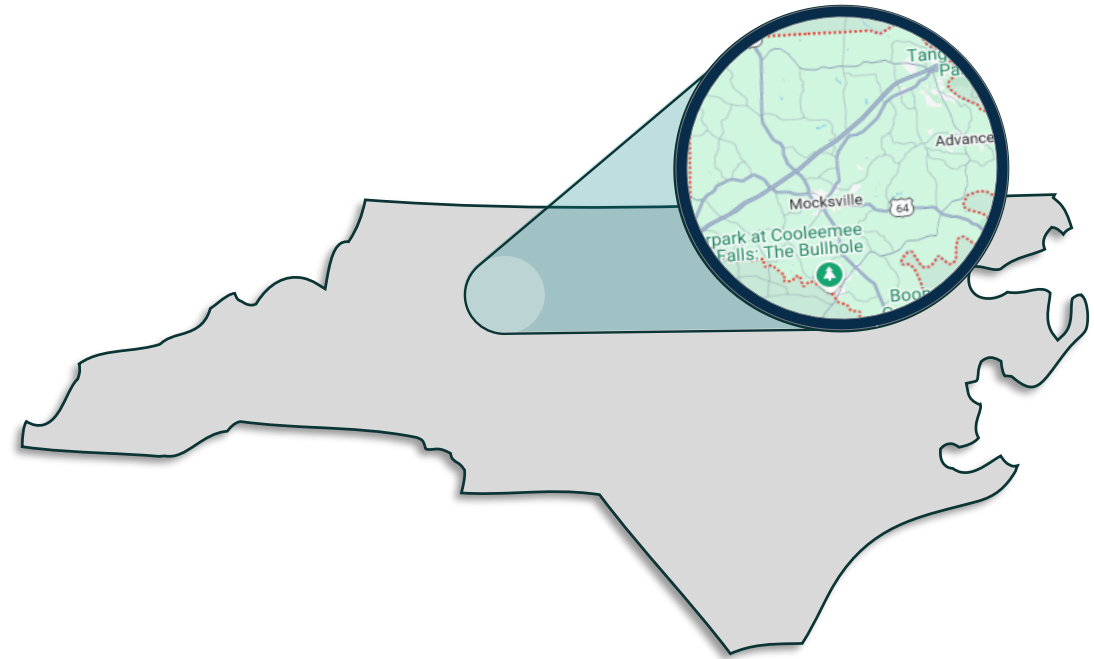


# Community Health Needs Assessment

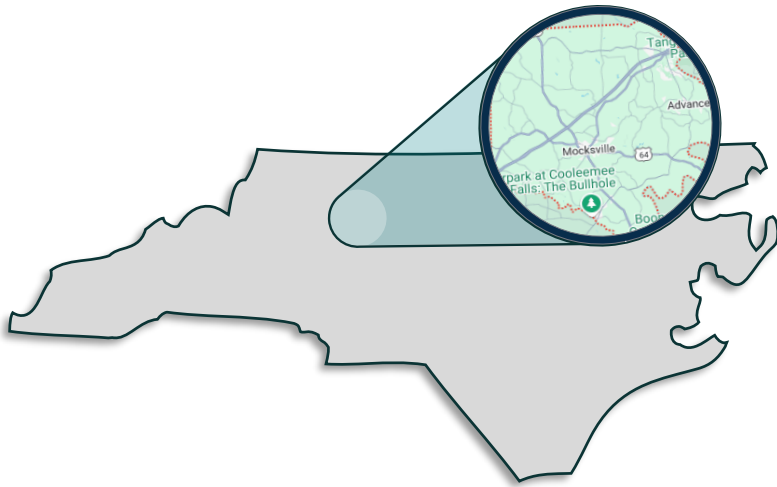
